Order of the Rector of PJAiT  
of 22 November 2021

concerning temporary limitation of functioning of the Academy due to the need to prevent,  
contain and eradicate COVID-19 in the community of Polish-Japanese Academy of  
Information Technology

On the basis of art. 23 section 1 and 2 point 2, art. 50 section 1 act of 20 July 2018, Law of  
higher education and science (i.e. Dz. U. of 2021 r., item. 478 with modifications) and § 21  
section 1 and section. 3 pt 5 Statute of Polish – Japanese Academy of Information  
Technology the following has been decided:

## § 1.

1. In the period from 25 November 2021 to 12 December 2021 inclusive, the following are  
suspended:
  - a) Traditional (on campus) lectures, tutorials, labs, language classes, seminars and other  
didactic activities;
  - b) Foreign trips (participation in mobility programmes) and participation in conferences  
in Poland of academic staff, reasearch staff, doctoral students, students and  
administrative staff members of PJAiT;
  - c) Visits of foreign students, doctoral students, academic teachers, research staff and  
administrative staff;
  - d) Visits of foreign guests;
  - e) Conferences and other events hosted by PJAiT on campus;
  - f) Organization of matura courses, preparation courses and trainings on PJAiT campus.
2. In rare and justified cases, a decision to make an exception to the rule regarding  
activities mentioned above may be made by the Rector.

3. In cases of meetings or other activities which will be held on campus following the Rector's approval, it is necessary to observe the health and safety procedures outlined in the Order of the Rector of PJAiT of 3 November 2021 concerning the functioning of Polish-Japanese Academy of Information Technology during the COVID-19 epidemic in Poland.

§ 2.

1. Lectures, tutorials, labs, language classes, seminars and other didactic activities listed in § 1. 1 will be held online. Similarly, workshops, trainings, conferences and other events may be organized in that mode.
2. For the period mentioned in § 1.1, the regulations from the Order of the Rector of Polish-Japanese Academy of Information Technology of 27 September 2021 concerning the organization of studies in the academic year 2021/2022 are suspended, except for those pertaining to the teaching and assessment, including exams in the remote learning mode (e-learning).

§ 3.

The order is effective from the day it is signed.
