

REGULATION OF THE DEAN

November 22, 2021

Re.: Selection of a second specialization and completion of studies by students pursuing 2 specialization

Following the Regulation of Studies (§33, art. 9 and §35 art. 2) and the Statute of PJATK (§23) it is determined that:

§1

At the student's request, the Dean may permit the selection of a second specialization. The permission is granted for a specific time and in case of not passing specialization courses, the permission can be revoked. Courses from the second specialization that have not been passed are annulled and are not taken into account in the grade point average. Students resigning from the second specialization need to pay a handling fee (according to the Table of Fees – Regulation of the Chancellor re.: tuition).

§2

- a. In the case of pursuing two specializations, the Student is obliged to write and submit two diploma theses and take two diploma examinations.
- b. To be admitted to the diploma examination, the student must complete the program of studies (including passing all courses) connected with the given specialization and a diploma thesis.
- c. Students who have declared pursuing an additional specialization, may proceed with the diploma examination on the condition that they have met the above-mentioned requirements even without passing all courses of the additional specialization. Before the diploma examination, these students should submit a request to register for the next semester in order to complete missing courses and participate in the defense of the thesis.

§3

Graduates, who have completed two specialization during the course of studies, receive 1 diploma (with a leading specialization) and an annotation indicating the leading specialization in the diploma supplement and a certificate confirming the second specialization.

§4

The Regulation shall enter into force on the date of signature.
