REGULATION of the Dean

October 28, 2024

Re.: selection of a second speciality area, change of speciality area, and thesis supervisor.

In accordance with the Study Regulations:

§1

Upon student's request, the Dean may allow for the completion of a second speciality area. The permission is granted for a specific period, and in the event of a lack of credits for particular speciality area courses, it may be revoked, and the failed courses from the second speciality area will be voided and not counted towards the grade average. For withdrawing from the additional speciality area within the deadline, a processing fee is applicable according to the fee schedule (Chancellor's Regulation on Tuition).

§2

- 1. In the case of pursuing two speciality areas, the student is obligated to write and submit two theses. The student will take the diploma exam twice but will receive one diploma (with the leading speciality area).
- 2. The student will receive an entry in the diploma supplement for the leading speciality area and a certificate for the second speciality area.
- 3. The condition for taking the diploma exam is the completion of the study program (including passing all courses) related to one speciality area and the completion of the thesis.
- 4. Students who have declared an additional speciality area may take the diploma exam if they have met the above conditions, even if they have failed courses in the additional speciality area. These students should, before the diploma exam, submit an application for enrollment in the next semester to complete these courses and defend the additional thesis.

§3

Change of speciality area or supervisor:

1. Changing speciality area or supervisor is possible before the beginning of the semester, up to

the deadline for submitting student applications with course declarations for the next

semester. The student is obligated to notify the current supervisor of this change and obtain

the consent of the new supervisor..

2. If there are any differences in the curriculum due to a change of speciality area, the student is

required to complete those requirements

3. The Dean may not agree to a change of speciality area.

4. In the event of a change of supervisor immediately before the last semester of studies, the

current thesis topic cannot be continued. The student must determine a new thesis topic with

the newly chosen supervisor. In exceptional situations, the Dean may allow for the

continuation of the thesis topic.
