regarding the requirements for passing PRO project subjects for first cycle studies and SEM seminar subjects for second cycle studies;

for first cycle studies: PRO1, PRO2, PRO3 - full-time studies; PRO1, PRO2 - part-time studies and for second cycle studies: SEM1, SEM2, SEM3 - full-time studies; SEM1, SEM2, SEM3, SEM4 - part-time studies.

Hereinafter referred to as PRO/SEM.

Full-time first-cycle programme:

- PRO1 – selection of the supervisor and possibly the project team and approval by the supervisor of the approximate topic of the dissertation, analysis of the problem domain/preliminary prototype of the practical part of the dissertation;
- PRO2 – completed, fully functional prototype of the practical part and significant part of the documentation, approximately 30% of the dissertation;
- PRO3 – approved by the supervisor, completed practical and theoretical part and positive result of anti-plagiarism check.

Part-time first cycle programme:

- PRO1 – selection of the supervisor and possibly the project team and approval by the supervisor of the approximate topic of the dissertation, analysis of the problem domain/preliminary prototype of the practical part of the dissertation, outline of the written dissertation, completion of approximately 30% of the practical part of the dissertation;
- PRO2 – the practical and theoretical parts of the dissertation approved by the supervisor, the practical and theoretical parts completed and a positive result of the anti-plagiarism check.

Full-time second cycle programme:

- SEM1 – selected supervisor, defined dissertation topic, completed problem domain analysis/research plan;
- SEM2 – selected dissertation method approved by supervisor, approximately 30% of dissertation preparation, e.g. completed theoretical chapter or advanced practical section;
- SEM3 – completion of research according to the agreed research plan, submission of the dissertation and positive result of anti-plagiarism check.

Part-time second cycle programme:

- SEM1 – selection of supervisor and approval of broad thesis topic and research plan by supervisor;
- SEM2 – completed analysis of problem domain, outline of dissertation;
- SEM3 – completed research tool, significant progress in preparation of thesis approximately 30% - 40%, e.g. completed theoretical chapter or advanced practical part;
- SEM4 – completion of the research according to the agreed research plan, submission of the thesis and positive result of the anti-plagiarism check.
