SUMMARY

LIMIT OF PLACES:

100 places for students in twin rooms in two- and three-room segments.

ADDRESS:

Konarskiego 1, 01-355 Warsaw, Poland.

TRANSPORTATION:

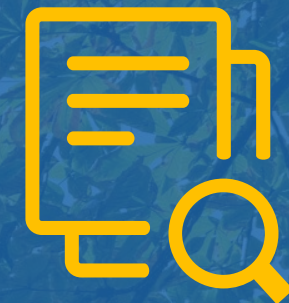
To PJAiT: Bus + tram = 35 min, Metro M2 + tram = 25 min.

STRUCTURE OF A TWO-ROOM (4-PERSON) SEGMENT:

- two rooms (each equipped with beds, wardrobes, bedside tables, and two wall-mounted shelves);
- a toilet and a shower;
- a furnished and equipped kitchen with a dining area (includes electric stoves and a refrigerator).

NOTE:

The dormitory does not provide personal hygiene items, bed linen (pillowcase, sheet, and duvet cover), towels, or kitchenware.



FEES

ACCOMMODATION ELIGIBILITY:

Only students on the official housing list, who have signed the rental agreement, completed the formalities, and paid the fees and deposit, are allowed to stay in the dormitory.

PAYMENT DEADLINES:

Students must pay their accommodation fees in advance by the 10th of each month.

RENTAL PERIOD:

The dormitory place is assigned for the duration of the rental agreement. Usually, it ends on July 31th.

BOOKING

STEP 1

Be sure that you have completed the admission process, signed the contract with PJAiT, and paid the tuition fee.



STEP 2

You should contact the Admission Office via email at rekrutacja@pja.edu.pl to inquire about the availability of places.

STEP 3

Once you receive confirmation that places are still available, you can register by filling out the form. After your application has been verified, we will send you confirmation that you have been added to the official housing list. You will then be assigned a room with one of the students from PJAiT, as only twin rooms are available.

STEP 4

Upon arrival in Warsaw, you will sign a contract at the dormitory reception and receive an individual account number for making accommodation payments in the following months.

Please confirm your move-in date and time by phone with the dormitory manager a few days before arrival at +48 22 551-21-42. Usually, students are allowed to move in on working days between 8:00 and 16:00.

DORMITORY RULES

QUIET HOURS:

Residents must observe quiet hours from 22:00 to 06:00.

ROOM MAINTENANCE:

Students must keep their rooms and dormitory facilities clean and in good condition.

CLEANING BEFORE CHECK-OUT:

Before moving out, students must clean their room, kitchenette, kitchen, hallway, bathroom, and toilet, regardless of the departure order of roommates.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS:

The dormitory management is not responsible for students' personal belongings.

ROOM DAMAGES:

Students are responsible for any damage or missing equipment in their assigned room and must cover the repair costs.

AGREEMENT TERMINATION REASONS:



- Not paying fees for your accommodation on time.
- Smoking anywhere in the dormitory is not allowed.
- Having, drinking, or sharing alcohol in the dorm is strictly forbidden.
- Any other reasons listed in Paragraph 5 of the dormitory rules.
