Pursuant to Article 108(2)(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), I hereby order the following:

In the case of an extension of the duration of first- or second-cycle studies by more than 2 years (4 semesters) or after the resumption of studies:

1. Grades are transferred to the current study programme, i.e. the programme for the year with which the student will graduate. The student is obliged to complete the differences in the curriculum.
2. Grades are not subject to transfer if more than 7 years have passed since they were obtained, regardless of the university at which the grade was obtained.
3. Only grades obtained in the same degree studies are subject to transfer. In particular, it is not possible to transfer the grade obtained in first-cycle studies to the credit of the subject of second-cycle studies.
4. The Dean may assign a maximum of 5 subjects to a student not resulting directly from curriculum differences the completion of which is related to the updating of knowledge.
5. The diploma thesis is valid for 2 years from its submission. Failure to defend within this deadline is associated with the need to write a new diploma thesis and repeat the last part of the PRO or SEM subject.

The Order comes into effect into force on the day of signing.
