

**Resolution No. 5/2024
Dated: March 22, 2024**

Regarding: Update of the rules for awarding diplomas with distinction at the Faculty of Information Management

§1

Pursuant to §17(2)(7) of the Statute of the Polish-Japanese Academy of Information Technology and §37(6) of the Study Regulations, the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Information Management establishes the conditions that must be met by a graduate to receive a diploma with distinction.

A graduate of the Faculty of Information Management may receive a diploma with distinction provided that all of the following conditions are met:

- Completion of studies within the timeframe defined by the curriculum and study plan, in accordance with §2(4) of the Study Regulations of PJATK;
- Achievement of a grade point average (GPA) of at least 4.5 during the course of studies;
- Receiving a grade of 5.0 for the diploma thesis from both the supervisor and the reviewer;
- Receiving a grade of 5.0 for the diploma exam;
- Recommendation of the diploma thesis for distinction by the Examination Committee upon the proposal of the reviewer or the Committee Chair, due to its exceptional academic merit;
- No violations of the oath taken upon enrollment (as defined in §46 of the PJATK Statute), particularly meaning that no disciplinary penalty has been imposed on the student.

Information about the distinction is included in the Diploma Supplement under "Additional Information."

The Diploma Supplement is issued in Polish and, upon the student's request, also in English.

This Resolution comes into force on the date of its adoption.
